Where: Meet in the Hepburn Plaza public parking lot, Hepburn St., Williamsport
Directions: Drive on Route 220 to Williamsport, Lycoming County. Take Hepburn Street exit. Stay on Hepburn Street. Drive north 0.32 miles. Turn left (west) onto West Edwin Street & then turn right into the Hepburn Plaza. Public parking available in the center of the parking area. (Map of the cleanup walking route will be provided after you register with CleanScapes-see below.)

When: April 13 from 10 AM-12 PM

Community Cleanup Activity to Beautify the City of Williamsport

Litter Crew: To kick start the week-long Susquehanna Greenway Partnership (SGP) Richard James Memorial Cleanup, CleanScapes participants will remove litter from 1 mile of sidewalk right-of-ways on Little League Blvd. & West Fourth St. Cleaning up these public areas, before SGP April 22-28 event, will highlight the importance of litter-free public spaces. Long pants are recommended & closed toes shoes are mandatory (no bare feet or sandals). An extra jacket, hat, & shoes are highly recommended. Youth between the ages of 12-17 must be accompanied by a participating adult.



Also needed: Truck Transport Driver Load filled trash bags into your truck, drive to the nearby drop-off location & unload the filled bags. (Truck bed may get muddy or scratched.)
